Airdrie Emergency Services Personnel Become Unionized

Airdrie, AB – Airdrie Emergency Services personnel voted this morning to become unionized with representation through the International Association of Fire Fighters (IAFF). The vote passed with 79% of personnel in favour of the unionization.

“We will remain focused on continuing to provide exceptional fire and emergency services to Airdrie residents. Service levels will remain unchanged,” says George Keen, City Manager.

The turn-out was almost 100% with 56 of 57 eligible voters placing their vote. All Emergency Services personnel, including paramedics, EMT’s and fire fighters are included. Emergency Services are the only sector of City of Airdrie employees that are unionized.
