

## **Permits for Decks**

### Do I need a permit for building a deck?

Anyone building a new deck, replacing or adding onto an existing deck needs to obtain a building permit. Other permits may also be required.

Exception: An uncovered deck less than 2 feet above finished grade does not require a permit.

## What do I need to apply for a deck permit?

- Permit Application
- A copy of your Real Property Report
- Deck plans and standard uncovered deck design form

#### **Contractor Information:**

If a contractor is constructing your deck, you will need to provide the name of the contractor who will be performing the work.

• Contractors require a City of Airdrie business license

# <u>Inspections</u> are required when the deck construction is completed or prior to the expiry of the permit.


## **<u>Real Property Report</u>** will need to be to scale and show:

- 1. the location of the proposed deck
- 2. the distance from the deck to the property lines and existing buildings




<u>Construction Plans</u> (plan and section) are required to be drawn to a scale of not less than 1:100 or legible drawing showing the following (see sample drawings below): Maximum paper size  $8 \frac{1}{2}$  x 14".

- A side elevation that shows the height of the deck, height of the railing with spindle/pickets spacing, concrete columns and stairs if applicable.
- Floor joist type and spacing
- Size and type of deck planking
- Size of deck (length, width, height)
- Size of beams and number of piles
- Size and type of columns and spacing
- Guard
- Handrails
- Stairs (rise and run)
- Type of foundation

#### **Some Basic Requirements**

- 1. Decks over 2 feet (600mm) above grade have setback requirements. Please contact the Planning & Development department for specific information: (403) 948-8848.
- 2. Beam members must be secured together and supported on top of the supporting posts. The width or diameter of a support post cannot be less than the width of the beam being supported.
- 3. Any wood within 6" must be adequately protected or use preserved wood.
- 4. A handrail must be provided for stairs with more than three steps and be mounted between 865mm and 965mm measured vertically from the stair nosing. If the handrail is acting as a guard it must be mounted between 900mm and 1070mm.
- 5. Guards are required for decks over 2 feet high. If the deck floor is 2' to 5' 11" above ground level, guards must be a minimum of 36" (900mm) high. If the deck floor is over 5' 11" (1.8m) above ground, level guards must be 42" (1072mm) high.
- 6. Deck bench brackets have special requirements. Please call (403) 948-8832 for information.
- 7. Guards around decks must be designed so there is no opening larger than 100mm (4").
- 8. Foundation support columns for attached decks must penetrate the frost level the same depth as the building or a minimum of 4 feet. **Exception:** When the distance from finished ground to the underside of the joists is not more than 600 mm (2 ft), not supporting a roof and not attached to a structure.
- 9. There will be additional requirements if you intend to cover or enclose your deck.
- 10. Other conditions may apply once a full plan review is completed by the Safety Codes Officer.
