

UTILITY RATES for 2017

City Council recently approved the rates to be charged for Water, Sewer and Waste Management effective January 1, 2017.

Please refer to the chart below for a breakdown of the rates changes:

Water - Fixed Daily Charge	\$ 0.64	\$ 0.70
Water - Consumption Rate per m ³	1.5243	1.6420
Sewer - Fixed Daily Charge	0.79	0.85
Sewer - Consumption Rate per m ³	1.5218	1.6095
Waste & Organics Collection - Fixed Daily Charge	0.61	0.61
Environmental Fee* - Fixed Daily Charge	0.24	0.24
Average Residential Utility Bill	\$109.53	\$ 115.97

*Waste and Environmental Fees will be adjusted later in 2017 when curbside recycling begins

The average residential utility bill for a customer using 15 cubic metres of water will increase to \$115.97. Customers using more or less than 15 cubic metres would see a corresponding larger or smaller increase.

- More than \$240,000 has been returned to residents through the toilet rebate program
