

Helpful **HOLIDAY** Tips



Christmas lights

Christmas lights and electronic decorations can be recycled at the Recycle Depot.



Broken Christmas decorations

Broken Christmas decorations are garbage. If sharp place in puncture proof container and dispose of in garbage.



Dry Cardboard

Remove all tape, flatten and place into your blue cart or bring cardboard to the Recycle Depot (*no excess next to your cart*).



Ribbons, bows & tinsel

Reduce or save for next year or another holiday. Ribbons, bows, tinsel, cellophane and foil wrapping paper are garbage.



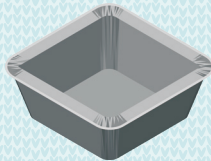
Gift bags & boxes

Reuse for next year!



Recyclable wrapping paper

Greeting cards, envelopes, tissue paper and plain wrapping paper can be placed into your blue cart or taken to the Recycle Depot (*no foil/shiny wrapping paper*).



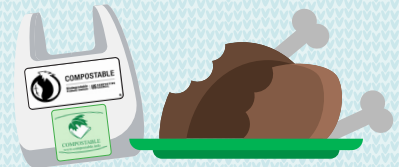
Aluminum foil

Rinse well & recycle clean aluminum foil pans and plates in your blue cart.



Polystyrene foam packaging

Bring clean packaging polystyrene foam to the Recycle Depot. Remove all tape. (*no food related styrofoam accepted*).



Leftovers

Reuse, freeze food or place food in your green cart (*compostable bags only*).



Batteries & old electronics

Recycle batteries and electronics at the recycle depot.



Clothing

Bring to the clothing donation bins at the Recycle Depot.



Carts gotta close

Carts need to close to be collected. Bring any excess recycling to the Recycle Depot (*no material can stick out or be placed beside cart*).



Fake Christmas trees

Reuse or dispose of at the Transfer Site.

Real Christmas trees

Remove all decorations and bring to the Recycle Depot from Dec. 27 to Jan. 30 to be chipped (*no tree bags, branches or leaves*).



Recycle Depot holiday hours
