

## **Occupancy Check List**

(Commercial, Industrial & Large Residential)

- 1. Please ensure the building has <u>not been occupied</u> prior to calling for a final inspection. Non-compliance can result in fines and or prosecution under the City of Airdrie Building Permit Bylaw and Safety Codes Act. If the tenant wants to partially occupy the building/bay (e.g. set up the interior of the store) prior to final inspection by the Building Inspections Department the following will be required;
  - (a) The retained professional indicated in the A-1 and A-2 Schedules provided prior to the commencement of the job will be required to provide in writing their approval and conditions of partial occupancy.
  - (b) The construction of the building must meet the requirements of STANDATA 19-BCB-004 (Occupancy of Buildings under Construction)
- 2. Prior to calling for a final inspection provide the Building Inspections Department with the following documentation if applicable;
  - (a) Sprinkler Verification
  - (b) Fire Alarm Verification (The verification must indicate that a monitoring system has been installed and is functioning).
  - (c) C-1 Schedules from the coordinating professional (architectural). C-2 Schedules from the structural, mechanical, electrical and geotechnical professionals)
- 3. Arrange for a final inspection;
  - (a) Inspections for Building, HVAC, Plumbing, Gas and Electrical can be arranged through your <u>MyAirdrie</u> account; by email: <u>inspection.requests@airdrie.ca</u> or through the inspection line Ph: 403-948-8832
  - (b) Inspections for Health must be made through the Alberta Health Services if applicable.
  - (c) Inspections for Fire can be arranged by calling (403) 948-8880
- 4. Occupancy will be granted once all the final inspections have passed.
