Airdrie, AB – **The Level II Fire Ban has been lifted within the City of Airdrie as of 4 p.m. Tuesday, October 9, 2012.** A positive change in weather has lowered the risk of fire due to dry/windy conditions.

To ensure that our fire risk within the City of Airdrie remains low, please ensure that fire pits and burnable debris practices conform to Airdrie's Fire Bylaw and use an extra degree of caution by not leaving any fire unattended.
