Open! 24 St from Yankee Valley Blvd to Sagewood Dr

AIRDRIE, ALBERTA – In the afternoon of Thursday, November 8, 24 St will re-open. The Mayor and City of Airdrie would like to thank residents for their patience during construction as crews have been at work, since June, rebuilding and repaving the roadway.

“Having 24 St re-opened makes travelling around the city much easier for residents and emergency services,” said Mayor Peter Brown. “The new fire station on Yankee Valley Blvd and an improved 24 St roadway are great examples of capital spending that directly benefits our residents; now and for many years to come.”

24 St was upgraded due to growth and was funded with development contributions and off-site levies. This completes the first two stages of the current \$7 MM project. The third stage includes installing traffic signals and widening at the intersection of Yankee Valley Blvd and 24 St in 2013.

“Residents will notice a big improvement over the old road conditions with a new paved surface and increased sight distance,” said Bob Neale, Engineering Services.

The 24 St roadway project is part of the \$31 MM 2012 City of Airdrie capital project budget that also included Railway Avenue and the new Water Supply line from Calgary.
