## **Art in Motion to Roll a Second Year**

Airdrie, Alberta – After a successful first year, Airdrie Transit and Creative Airdrie’s Art in Motion initiative will continue to showcase local artists in 2012/13.

“Last year was the first time in its 30 year history that Airdrie Transit’s passes were more than just a way to board the bus,” commented Chris MacIsaac, Transit Coordinator with the City of Airdrie. “The passes last year were vibrant, exciting and displayed the immense visual art talent in our community. We are delighted to provide this opportunity again in our next series of passes.”

“Creative Airdrie is thrilled that Art in Motion is an opportunity to put Airdrie Artists and their art in the hands of so many people,” added Linda Bruce, Executive Director of Creative Airdrie.

The call is out for local artists who would like their work promoted throughout the city and region to submit a high resolution jpeg image of a finished piece. Artwork selected will be featured on the monthly bus passes starting September 2012 for both the regional Intercity Express (ICE) and local transit services (24 passes in total).

Last year, Art in Motion’s collection featured a variety of visual artists including painters, sculptors, photographers, textile artists and mixed media artists.

Artists can submit their images to [info@creativeairdrie.ca](mailto:info@creativeairdrie.ca) until June 15th. The 24 images will be selected June 21. Artists may submit as many images as they wish as multiple images from the same artist may be selected.
