Airdrie Intercity Express (ICE) Service Delayed

AIRDRIE, AB - The Airdrie Intercity Express (ICE) Service is delayed until further notice. A part on the bus was recalled by the manufacturer. The manufacturer has not announced when the new piece will be released. The recalled part affects all three new articulating buses for the ICE service.

“We are in contact with the manufacturer, and they are diligently working on providing a new part to replace the one they are recalling,” says Michelle Lock, Director of Community and Social Services. “As soon as we know when the manufacturer has a solution, we will announce the new launch date.”

The enhancements to the local transit will still take effect on October 1, 2010. The enhancements to this service include new buses, peak morning and afternoon schedules.

When launched, the City’s Intercity Express (ICE) service, is part of the Provincial Green Trip Fund, providing a public transit alternative for peak morning and afternoon commuters to and from Calgary.
